Report card grades will be determined by the following weighting systems:

Elementary K-2

10% Homework
15% Journals
65% Daily Class work
10% Tests

Elementary 3-5

10% Homework
15% Journals
50% Daily Class work
25% Major Tests/quiz

Secondary

10% Homework
15% Journals
30% Daily Class work
30% Major Tests
15% Quiz

HOMEWORK GUIDELINES

The following are baseline guides for homework:

Elementary

Not to exceed 60 minutes per day with at least 20 minutes of parent verified reading Monday through Thursday.

Middle School

Not to exceed 75 minutes per day with at least 20 minutes of parent verified reading Monday through Thursday.

High School

Not to exceed 90 minutes per day Monday through Thursday.

Students shall be expected to make up assignments and tests after absences. Students shall receive a zero for any assignment or test not made up within the allotted time.

TESTS

Students shall be permitted to take tests administered in any class missed because of absence.

For any class missed, the teacher may assign the student make-up work based on the instructional objectives for the subject or course and the needs of the individual student in mastering the essential knowledge and skills or in meeting subject or course requirements.

A student shall be responsible for obtaining and completing the make-up work in a satisfactory manner and within the time specified by the teacher.

LATE
PROJECTS

Teachers may assign a late penalty to any project turned in after the due date in accordance with previously established guidelines approved by the principal and disseminated to students.

UNEXCUSED
ABSENCES

The grade for make-up work after an unexcused absence shall be reduced by ten percent.

SUSPENSION

The District shall not impose a grade penalty for make-up work after an absence because of suspension.

EOC

When required by state law, a student's score on the initial end-of-course (EOC) assessment shall count for 15 percent of the student's final grade for the course as reported on the student's transcript.
